Service is provided in OKC (fares range from \$2 within the primary service areas to \$5 outside that area); Edmond (\$1 - \$1.50); and Norman (\$.25 - \$1.50). Service is provided one hour before or after the individual's desired departure time. Same day service is on a space available basis (24 hour notice needed to assure service).
